Lincoln update - Lincoln Principal, Mrs. Eklund

- 10/4 was International Walk to School Day – this is the first time Lincoln has all walked together; rain prevented the rally back at the school. Principal was joined by four staff members, a number of parents, and over 100 kids! One of the assistant superintendents took some pictures, so Lincoln had some good publicity.
- PARCC scores are going home Fri 10/6.
- In October, a Title 1 meeting will be scheduled; all parents are invited. The purpose is to talk about the funding and how it gets used in the building. Lincoln receives about \$100,000, which is mostly used for interventionists. The school is required to earmark a % of the money for parent/family engagement, such as math/reading nights).

Budget Update – Lisa Benson

- Mrs. Eklund held a meeting with the teachers to prioritize PTO support funding for the year. We had to decrease funding in some areas, as the income budget is currently at a conservative amount (\$4k vs. approximately \$9k raised in prior years). We are trying some different fundraisers this year; if we have great results, we can allocate additional monies. The areas of agreed upon spending can be found in the middle section of the attached budget report.
